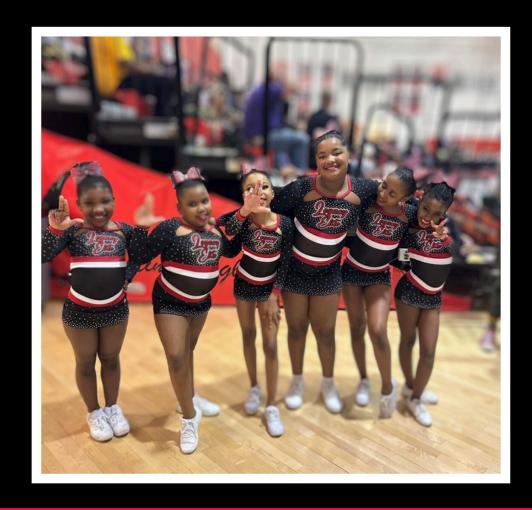

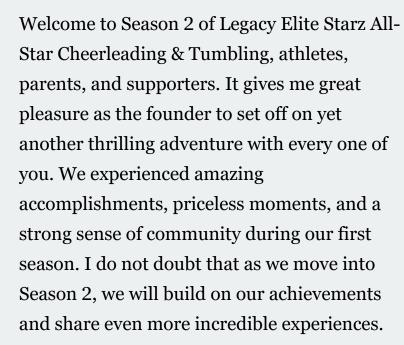

Legacy Elite Team Placement

All-Star Cheerleading is a sport that demands dedication from athletes and their parents. Families need to know that athletes are assessed for the Legacy Elite Starz all-star program and not for a particular team. Legacy Elite places Athletes on teams where their skills will most help the team and program overall.

We want every member to represent the gym in a responsible, classy, and sportsmanlike manner. Any athlete or parent who violates the terms and conditions of the gym acts in a way that damages the Legacy Elite brand's name or reputation may face consequences, including program termination without a refund.

Evaluating Athlete's Skills for Placements

We want every athlete to have the opportunity to showcase their strength, confidence, and skill to be placed on a team. For this reason, we evaluate team athletes for several weeks before formally assigning them to teams. An athlete can perform differently depending on the amount of adrenaline and nervousness they are experiencing. So that every athlete can give it their all, we strive to make the evaluation process as stress- and injury-free as possible. Before teams are created, "An Evaluation Session" allows our staff to spend enough time with your child to ensure level-appropriate placement and a good season for everyone.

When evaluations take place, our organization aims to provide our staff with the safest and most accurate way to measure athlete talents.

On the first day, we assign the athletes to temporary teams after making the initial evaluations. Over the next few weeks, we'll keep switching up the athletes until we have the most accurate and effective team. Following that, at our June team ceremonies, our teams will be officially announced.

Technique-driven warm-up exercises, jumps, tumbling, stunting, and choreography will be the main areas of evaluation.

At the time of team formation, athlete placement will be determined by skill level and technique.

- Most athletes will be grouped based on age group and ability level. When placing crossover athletes, athletes with unique skill sets, or athletes who have aged out of a level, exceptions may be granted.
- Never is team placement set in stone. At any point during the season, athletes who either improve or regress in their skill performance may be transferred to another team.

Practice time will be utilized to improve team dynamics and concentrate on regular elements when rosters are set. Team practice will not give much opportunity to improve tumbling abilities.

The main goals of team tumbling are technique and team coordination. There is some skill development, although athletes are urged (but not forced) to add more classes or individual instruction to their regimen.

FEATURES AND AGE ELIGIBILITY

At every phase of training, we celebrate your child's accomplishments in a secure and encouraging atmosphere. Athletes will develop character strength by learning important lessons in self-discipline, resiliency, teamwork, and dedication in addition to gaining the ability and confidence to compete at the top level.

Novice Program

The NOVICE program aims to expose newcomers to the competitive world of All-Star cheerleading. The only requirements are the capacity for active listening, a strong work ethic, and a desire to have fun. The basics of performance cheerleading will be taught to athletes, who will then perform their routine for judges to comment on. Although novice teams aren't truly rated against one another, there are occasions when the top team at that level can be determined.

Prep Program

Athletes with some cheerleading experience or general athletic ability are intended for the PREP program. For families that are either new to the sport or do not have the financial means to commit to the travel and expenses of an Elite team, prep teams provide the ideal "bridge" program. Prep athletes receive the same qualified coaching and skill development as our full-season Elite program, even though they practice and compete on fewer days. Every season, athletes have the option to rejoin the program or use their expertise to advance to our Elite program.

Financial Obligations

Refunds

There are no refunds for any payments made. Management must be notified via email if you decide to exit the program. July 1st is the final day to leave the program without incurring a penalty. A \$250 drop fee will be assessed to athletes who withdraw between July 2nd and September 2nd. A \$500 drop fee is imposed on athletes who withdraw by September 3rd or later. Any purchased apparel that is not delivered to the gym at the time of drop-off is forfeited. To maintain their "spot," athletes who have a temporary injury yet want to rejoin their team must continue to make the required payments. A letter from a physician is required. Tuition and fees for the regular season are spread out evenly over 10 months, from June to April. Competition registration, coach travel, camps, costumes, choreography, and music are all included in the fees.

If necessary, additional fees will be billed on the specified day. There will be no fees for athletes who already have a uniform. In May, only athletes who participate in post-season events will be billed. The USASF and or the AAU only receives the member fee directly from that organization. You are unable to "opt-out" of Post

Seasonal events: The listed price includes tuition, apparel, regular choreography updates, and coaches' fees. Depending on the bid type (Paid, At Large), additional event registration fees may be required. These amounts will be paid to the event producer directly. A 3.5% processing fee will be applied to all electronic payments starting on June 1, 2024.

Our processing systems will automatically retrieve all payments.

Also not included in Team Fees: USASF or AAU Membership (Due September 1), Hotel & Airfare (when necessary), Parent & Sibling entrance fees & parking, Crossover Competition fees, and ALL End-of-season bid Events for teams that qualify.

Past Due Account

Please be sure to adhere to the payment due date. If your past due account is 30 days past due your athlete will be asked to sit down. If your athlete has a past-due balance, your athlete cannot participate in any Legacy practices, evaluations, classes, private lessons, etc. In addition, an athlete with a past-due account will not be permitted to participate in private/group tumbling.

Choreography/Skills & Music

Each athlete must pay a Choreography Fee/Skill Camp Fee for their routine. For Season 2, the choreography and skills camp will be divided into two sections, both of which are mandatory. Section 1 (Skills) will take place in July. Section 2 will be scheduled in August.

Optional Items

Optional accessories include the Warmup Jacket, Leggings, Backpack, and other things that have been added to the ProShop. However, we strongly advise you to at least purchase a team cheer backpack for your athlete.

Parent Association/Club

For Season 2, we are excited to introduce the Parent Association/Club, dedicated to providing support for our gym, athletes, and coaching staff.

Rules & Regulations

Legacy Elite Starz prioritizes adherence to rules, regulations, and guidelines both on and off the mat, within our gym, and throughout our community.

A comprehensive Parent/Athlete Handbook will be provided upon registration, detailing all regulations in full.

Legacy Elite Starz Communications

We understand that it is not always easy to contact your team's coach before, during, or after practice. To maintain an open line of communication, we will give you many avenues to contact us with your concerns and suggestions and we will strive to continuously improve communication channels. Please speak to us directly or send an email to legacyelitestarz@gmail.com This allows you to voice your opinion, positively, express concerns for your athlete, give us new information that we may need to know, etc. You may indicate if you would like for someone to call you back or if you would like to make an appointment. We will try to get back to you promptly.

Attendance for Summer (June 3 – Sept. 2)

There can be up to four (4) vacation days. Attendance at all camp dates and choreography is required.

Attendance during the Fall/Winter season (September 3 – April 29)

There can be up to three (4) excused absences; however, any more than that could interfere with regular positions. We suggest reserving these for important life events (weddings, ceremonies, etc.) or sick days.

Required Competition Practices

Absences without permission are not permitted 14 days before any event. Absences, whether excused or not, are not permitted seven days before an event, including any extra practices that may be planned.

Following evaluation registration, a formal calendar will be sent to you via email. One of the following will happen if this policy is broken:

- Withdrawal from the competition (without refund)
- Permitted to participate, but excluded from all group portions of the performance, including stunts (only taken into consideration if the absence complies with the policies for excused absences and doesn't adversely affect the team)

The following skills are examples for each level. While we take potential into consideration, mos athletes will be able to consistetly execute all the level appropriate skills, and many athletes will be able to execute advanced skills with proper technique to be placed on a particular level.
